Regarding the COVID-19 Vaccination

Dec 17 ~ present

3rd dose (booster shot)

This information as of Dec 17 is subject to change.

Any changes such as the type of vaccine administered, who is eligible for the vaccine etc., will be made public via the Ichinoseki City Homepage and the city newsletter 'I-style'.

[When can I get my 3rd dose?]

The 3rd dose can be administered 8 months after your second dose.

However, the interval can be shortened depending on the circumstance of the person receiving the injection.

Those eligible	When 3 rd dose is given	
People working in the medical field People who live/work in age care facilities People admitted to hospital	More than 6 months after the second dose	
Persons aged 65 and over (other than the above listed)	More than 7 months after the second dose (However, injections will be administered after February 2022.)

Vaccination Tickets

- Once you are eligible for the 3rd dose, a ticket will be sent in the mail.
- Those who had their 2nd dose by May 2021 did not receive their vaccination ticket in December, contact the Health Promotion Division or the Health and Welfare Division of each branch.

[Vaccines administered]

Pfizer

Takeda/Moderna

- * Type of vaccine administered depends on venue.
- * Since both are mRNA types, rather than choosing between the two, please choose depending on which is available to you sooner.
- * The amount of Takeda/Moderna vaccine administered is half the amount of the first and second shots.

Further information on 3rd dose

Why is a 3rd dose necessary?

The efficacy of the vaccine will gradually decrease over time. The third dose is to increase efficacy and to prevent people from getting the coronavirus or severe symptoms.

What kind of side effects are there?

The same as the 1st and 2nd doses.

l've lost the document to prove that I received the 1st and 2nd doses of vaccine. What should I do?

When Ichinoseki City sends the ticket for the 3rd dose, it will send proof of vaccination of 1st and 2nd doses. If you need the vaccination ticket before it arrives, please consult with the Health Promotion Division or the Health and Welfare Division of each branch. If you are new to living in Ichinoseki after receiving the first or second dose, please inquire with the municipality where you lived prior to coming to Ichinoseki.

Can I choose which vaccine for the third dose? What if I receive a vaccine that is different from the first and second doses?

For the third dose, you can receive either the Pfizer vaccine or the Takeda/Moderna vaccine regardless of the type of vaccine you had for the first or second dose. There is no change in the efficacy and safety of the vaccine.

l'd like a to make a reservation, what should I do?

[Make a reservation before your ticket arrives] *Only for people over 65 years old

- (1) Make a reservation with your primary physician
- (2) Make a reservation via postcard

If you wish to have Ichinoseki City organize your vaccination venue and date, please return the postcard to Ichinoseki City.

[Make a reservation after the vaccination ticket arrives]

- (3) Make a reservation at a medical facility/call center/internet
- * Please check the December issue for detailed information.

[Persons eligible for 1st and 2nd dose]

- (1) Persons who will be 12 years old after December 2021 (a vaccine ticket will be sent on the last day of the birthday month).
- (2) Persons who have not been vaccinated that newly moved to Ichinoseki City after December 2021.
- (3) Persons who could not be vaccinated by December 2021 due to illness or other reasons/Persons who haven't been able to get their second dose.

[COVID-19 Vaccination Certificates can be issued on smartphone]

From December 20, 2021, COVID-19 vaccination certificates can be issued on smartphones using My Number, and can be used both domestically and internationally.

In addition to smartphones, paper vaccine certificates can also be issued,

The vaccination certificate can be used as a document to prove that you received your vaccinations.

Be careful of water pipes freezing

When cold temperatures continue, water pipes may freeze. They freeze or break when the temperature drops below -4°C.

Water pipes are prone to freezing when

- the water pipes are exposed
- the pipes are exposed to strong winds
- the pipes are facing north and not exposed to sunlight

How to prevent freezing or breaking

- If installed, turn on the anti-freezing heater that is wrapped around the water pipe.
- If there is a "drain plug", drain the water pipe.

When pipes freeze

- Wrap a towel around the frozen part and slowly pour lukewarm water.
- * Caution: Pipes will break if hot water is applied directly.
- If you live in an apartment, contact the person who manages the apartment.
- If you cannot unfreeze the pipes yourself, contact a company that will carry out the work designated by Ichinoseki City (list found on Ichinoseki City HP).

Special money will be given to families with children

•Who is eligible for the handout?

Families with children under 18 are eligible for the handout and will have it automatically transferred during December.

There are some exceptions where you will need to fill out an application form to receive the money. Ichinoseki City will send application guides to families that need to fill out the form in December 2021.

These people include: civil servants receiving children's allowance (児童手当受給者), those who are raising only high school students or children's allowance recipients for children born by March 31, 2022 etc.

- •How much money will I receive? 100,000yen per child

Please fill in the application documents and send them to the inquiry counter (Child Care Support Division 子育て支援課) by mail or directly with the necessary documents.

Applications can also be made online.

• **Deadline:** Until Monday, February 28, 2022 When a child is born after March, please apply within 15 days of birth.
