Regarding the COVID-19 Vaccination

Vaccinations at Ichinoseki Gymnasium (Udome) will end in April

In April, the third vaccine dose at the Ichinoseki Gymnasium, as well as the first vaccine dose for children aged 5 to 11, will come to an end.

We will continue to vaccinate at medical institutions throughout the city beyond May. Those who wish to receive the vaccination should do so as soon as possible, 6 months after their second dose.

Third dose for 12 to 17 year olds

- O Currently, the 3rd dose is only available to people over 18 years of age, but it is being considered for people aged 12 to 17 who have received their 1st and 2nd doses in Japan from April at the earliest.
- O The city is preparing for vaccine distribution in line with instructions of the government.
- O Once 3rd doses for 12 to 17 years olds are determined, we will send the vaccination ticket and detailed information to those eligible.

First and second doses for newly eligible people

We will continue to administer the 1st and 2nd doses to those who are of the eligible age for vaccination and those who have not been able to receive vaccinations due to special circumstances.



Cervical cancer preventive vaccine (HPV vaccine) Routine vaccination

Pre-examination slips and vaccination tickets will be sent to girls of the age equivalent to 1st grade of junior high school and 1st grade of high school in early June. For girls of the age equivalent to junior high school grade 2 or 3 who wish to be vaccinated, contact the Child Care Support Division or the Health/Welfare Division of each branch and a pre-examination slip and vaccination ticket will be issued. If you wish to be vaccinated, please understand the effectiveness and safety of the vaccine before making your decision.

• Target demographic: Girls of the age equivalent to the first grade of junior high school to the first grade of high school (born between April 2, 2006 and April 1, 2010 in 2022)

Subsidized vaccination costs for mumps and rubella

(1) Mumps

- Target demographic: 1 to 2 year olds who are registered as Ichinoseki residents.
- * Not applicable to those who have had mumps or who have been vaccinated before.
- Grant amount: Full grant (one time only)
- Preliminary examination slip and vaccination ticket: Issued at the time of 9 to 10 month child consultation
- Please bring your maternal and child health handbook and a form of ID.

(2) Adult rubella

If a pregnant woman gets rubella in the early stages of pregnancy, her child may develop congenital rubella syndrome (causing deafness, congenital heart disease). It's especially recommended to be protected for people who wish to become pregnant and their family members. Those who have previously received a grant are not eligible.

- Target: Registered residents of Ichinoseki
 ①People born between April 2, 1990 and April 1,
 2000 who have not been vaccinated with MR3 and
 Phase 4 ②April 2, 1973 ~ Women born between
 April 1, 1979 ③ People born between April 2, 1979
 and April 1, 1990
- Grant amount: MR 4,700 yen, Rubella 3,000 yen (only once)
- * The difference between the cost of the vaccine and the subsidy amount will be borne by you. Full subsidy for people in welfare households
- Preliminary examination slip and vaccine ticket: Issued by the medical institution where the examination is conducted. Please bring a form of ID.
 * For people in welfare households, it will be issued at the Ichinoseki City Hall Welfare Division or each branch.
- Period: Until March 31, 2023
- Vaccine times and holidays: Please contact each medical institution
- How to receive it: (1) Make a reservation with a medical institution (2) Receive an explanation about the vaccine at a medical institution and decide whether or not you'd like to go ahead with it.
