First through Third doses for newly eligible people

We will continue to administer the 1st through 3rd doses to those who are of the eligible age for vaccination and those who have not been able to receive vaccinations due to special circumstances.

To those who have not yet received their 3rd Dose

The number of new cases of COVID-19 have been rising nationwide.

Booster vaccination rates are especially low among those in their teens to thirties.

As we now enter the summer holidays, experts predict an increased chance of transmission.

To prevent the spread of the virus and serious illness when infected, we ask those who have not yet received their 3rd dose to consider getting vaccinated ahead of time.

Countermeasures Against COVID-19 Indoor & Outdoor Mask Wearing



- Mask wearing remains a basic and important step to prevent infection, just as it has so far.
- When outdoors, masks are not necessary when keeping a distance of 2m or more from other people, or if you are not talking at closer distances.
- When indoors, masks are not necessary when keeping a distance of 2m or more from other people **AND** you are not talking.



Outdoors

When outdoors, unless speaking to someone at a close distance, masks are not necessary.

In hot weather, wearing a mask can increase the risk of heat stroke. Let's remove our masks outdoors when masks are not necessary.



Indoors

When indoors, please wear a mask when speaking, regardless of your distance from others.

Even when not speaking, please continue to wear a mask in the following situations:

- when riding on a crowded bus or train,
- · when inside crowded shopping centers,
- · when meeting with the elderly,
- · when visiting a hospital, etc.

■ Preschool-aged children:

- Mask wearing **IS NOT** recommended for children under 2 years of age.
- Mask wearing is not uniformly required for children older than 2 years, regardless of their distance from others.

New Service for COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate Begins

① Vaccination certificates can be issued at convenience stores. (For a Fee)

Starting in mid-August, some convenience stores in the city will be able to issue paper certificates for COVID-19 vaccination.

- Necessary documents to apply for convenience store delivery:
 - ① My Number Card of the recipient
 - ② Issuance Fee 120 yen/certificate (as of 2022)
- ◆ Important points for convenience store delivery:
- Stores where the service can be used are limited, and the date the service begins at each store may differ.
- Fees cannot be refunded after printing the certificate.
- Vaccination certificates for international travel will require the issuance history from July 21st, 2022 (Thurs.) and on, received through the Health

Promotion Division or the vaccination certificate app.

- ② Digital vaccination certificates can be printed by oneself.
- You are now able to save an image of and print for yourself the digital vaccination certificate obtained through the vaccination certificate app.
- ◆ The ability to save the image will be available after installing the newest update for the app from the App Store or Google Play.
- ◆ The vaccination certificate received after updating the app is the image that can be saved.

- ♦ Cardiovascular examination, lung cancer screening, hepatitis virus screening (reception hours:9:30am ~ 11:00am/1:30pm~2:30pm)
- ♦ Gastric cancer screening, colorectal cancer screening (reception hours: 6:30am ~ 8:30am)
- ♦ Breast cancer screening (reception hours: 9:30am~10:30am/1:30pm~2:30pm)
- ♦ Cervical cancer screening (reception hours:9:30am~10:30am/1:00pm~2:00pm)

In addition to these, tuberculosis tests are also available.
