### Regarding the COVID-19 Vaccination

## [Vaccination Administration Period Expected to be Extended]

While the vaccine administration period decided nationally is only until September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022, it is expected to be extended from October on.

No charge for vaccines!

## [Vaccinations Targeting the Omicron Variant Begin]


Administration of the Omicron booster shots will begin rolling out starting in October. The booster shots are expected to be greatly effective in preventing severe illness, infection, and the appearance of symptoms against the Omicron coronavirus variant more than the vaccines currently in use.

Those Eligible Residents aged 12 years or older who have received their 1st and 2nd vaccinations

#### **Vaccination Procedure**

- Vaccinations will begin with those who have not yet received their 3<sup>rd</sup> dose, as well as those eligible for their 4<sup>th</sup> dose (people aged 60 years or older or who are at risk of serious illness, etc.) but who have not yet received it.
- Those 59 years or younger not yet eligible for the 4th dose, should get it once they receive their ticket.



<sup>\*</sup> Those who have moved or lost/damaged their ticket must get a new one issued. Please make a request to the Call Center or to the Health Promotion Division/the Health and Welfare Division at your local branch office.

Vaccination Venues Currently being finalized, but likely at city medical facilities as well as the Ichinoseki City Gym (U-Dome). Please confirm with the leaflet included with your vaccination ticket, or on the Ichinoseki City Homepage (as well as the official city LINE account) from late-September.

**How to Make an Appointment** Once you receive the vaccination ticket and check the included list of vaccination venues, please make an appointment at a city medical facility using the method indicated (online, through the call center, or contacting the facility directly).

### 3rd Doses for Children ages 5-11

The 3rd dose is being administered to children aged 5-11 years once 5 months has passed after their second vaccination.

### Vaccine Administered Pfizer vaccine for children

### Vaccination Ticket

- To be mailed to those eligible before the end of the 5th month after the second shot.
- Tickets for those who received their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose by May 2022 will be mailed on September 20<sup>th</sup> (Tues).

How to Make an Appointment Please make a reservation online or through the call center as soon as your vaccination ticket has arrived.

### First and second doses for newly eligible people

We will continue to administer the 1st and 2nd doses to those who are of the eligible age for vaccination and those who have not been able to receive vaccinations due to special circumstances.

Vaccinations for those 12 and older: Due to the start of the Omicron boosters, vaccinations are being scaled down and will only be administered at Showa Hospital (Tamura). (The Omicron booster cannot be administered for the first or second dose.)

Vaccinations for children ages 5-11: Vaccinations will be administered at the Ichinoseki City Gym (U-Dome) according to the schedule below, in addition to the 4 current medical facilities.

### Flu Shot Subsidy for Children & Seniors

In Ichinoseki, some of the costs of the influenza vaccine are subsidized for children and seniors.

- Subsidized Period: Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> (Sat)~Jan. 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023 (Tues)
- Please refer to the city <u>homepage</u> for info on:
- \* Those eligible and subsidized amounts
- \* Eligible Medical Facilities
  - Please make a reservation in advance at a medical facility.
  - Vaccination tickets and pre-vaccination questionnaire are distributed by participating facilities.
- Those wishing to get vaccinated at a non-participating facility should inquire at the numbers below.
- ■Note
- ① It is no longer necessary to wait before receiving the COVID-19 vaccine, and both may be administered at the same time.
- ② Vaccines cannot be administered to those with a fever greater than  $37.5^{\circ}$ C or a serious illness.

③ In some cases, the doctor may decide to postpone vaccination. Please consult with your doctor on a day you're in good health to be vaccinated.

### [Everyday Precautions are Important]

Vaccines are not guaranteed to completely prevent infection. Please be thorough with infection prevention measures such as mask-wearing, handwashing, and gargling.
