### **Regarding the COVID-19 Vaccination**

December 18 ~ present

### [Omicron Booster Vaccinations (3rd, 4th, 5th Doses) for those 12 and up]

The current vaccination schedule for COVID-19 has been decided nationally until March 31st, 2023. Those who wish to get vaccinated should be sure to do so before March 31st.

- Those who have caught COVID-19 before can also get vaccinated once they have recovered, regardless of when they were infected.
- The Omicron bivalent booster is limited to 1 dose per person.

### [January COVID-19 Vaccination Venues (1st and 2nd Doses)]

Because the Omicron bivalent booster is only available for those aged 12 years and older who have completed their 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccinations, the initial original doses are still being administered. Vaccinations are also available for children (aged 5-11) as well as young children (aged 6 months to 4 years).

### Please stay thorough in everyday COVID-19 preventive measures!

The symptoms and spread of the COVID-19 virus are increasing the burden on medical facilities. To prevent the spread of COVID-19, we request everyone's cooperation to keep up appropriate preventive measures.

#### O Requests for Basic Preventive Measures

- Please wear nonwoven cloth masks and thoroughly wash and disinfect your hands as appropriate.
- Please be sure to ventilate and watch humidity levels at your home and workplace.
- · We request that those wishing to be vaccinated do so as soon as possible in order to continue preventing symptoms and serious illness.

#### O Requests to Lessen the Burden on Medical Facilities

- We ask that those who are younger than 65 years of age, with no underlying conditions and a low risk of serious illness, make use of the Iwate Testing Kit Delivery Center if they develop a fever or other symptoms.
- For the New Year holidays, the city is also offering antigen test kits (see below).
- If symptoms continue, please consult with your doctor, in person or by phone, during weekday working hours when possible.

#### Over Winter Holidays, Test Kits for those with Symptoms but low risk of Serious Illness

To prevent the spread of the virus as well as ensuring the availability of doctors on duty for the medical care system during the New Year holidays, antigen test kits will be offered free of charge. For more details, please see the Ichinoseki City Homepage.

Those Eligible Residents of Ichinoseki City or Hiraizumi Town (including long-term visitors) who have symptoms of fever, cough, etc. \*Does not include those without symptoms. However, those who are at high risk of serious illness (those who are 65 years or older, who have underlying conditions, who are or may be pregnant, or who have a continuously high fever) are not eligible.

#### To Apply

Application forms can be filled out at participating centers the same day. Forms can also be downloaded from the Ichinoseki City Homepage.

#### **Notes**

- Can be applied for once per person.
- Please do not transfer, trade, or sell any test kits received.
- Please use the test kit yourself after referring to the instructions. (These test kits include a cotton swab to be inserted into the nasal cavity to gather a test sample.)

#### Requests

- In the case of a positive result, please register the necessary information with the Iwate Confirmed Cases Registration Center.
- · Those who have symptoms or are at risk of serious illness should consult with their doctors, in person or by phone.

The city will never ask you to visit an ATM or ask for your PIN number.

- (4) 3<sup>rd</sup> term of Long-term Care Insurance fees (general collection)
