Regarding the COVID-19 Vaccination

February 16 ~ present

Currently, the vaccination schedule for COVID-19 has been decided nationally up until March 31st, but it is expected to be extended from April on. Starting in April, the number of vaccination venues will be scaled down, so those who wish to be vaccinated should do so as soon as possible. In addition, information on vaccination periods and those eligible for April onwards will be included on the city homepage and in the April issue of *I-style*.

[Omicron Booster Vaccinations (3rd, 4th, 5th Doses) for those 12 and up through March]

This booster dose is expected to prevent infection and the development of symptoms, along with serious illness caused by the omicron variant. Currently, one shot is available per person. For vaccination venues, please check the city homepage or the February issue of *I-style* for multilingual information.



[March COVID-19 Vaccination Venues (1st and 2nd Doses)]

Because the Omicron bivalent booster is only available for those aged 12 years and older who have completed their 1st and 2nd vaccinations, the initial original doses are still being administered. Vaccinations are also available for children (aged 5-11) as well as young children (aged 6 months to 4 years).

Submitting Tax Payment Certificates during Car Inspections

The Vehicle Tax Confirmation System for Light Motor Vehicles began operating in January 2023. Through this system it is possible to confirm the payment status of vehicle tax online at the Light Motor Vehicle Inspection Organization, and it is now generally unnecessary to present the certification of tax payment for light motor vehicles (with 3 wheels or more) during inspections.

Two-wheel motor vehicles (with engine displacement more than 250cc) are not included in this system, and the tax payment certificate will still need to be presented at inspection.

* Certificates may still be necessary in cases such as immediately after tax payment, after purchasing a used vehicle, after moving from a different area, or when past payments are overdue.

Ichinoseki Childbirth & Child-rearing Support Services Begin

With the goal of equipping all child-rearing and expecting households with the means to securely give birth and raise children, consultation services and financial support through subsidies will be offered to households in all stages of pregnancy and/or childcare.

♦ Who is eligible for the subsidies?

City residents in any of the following four categories:

* For the subsidy, applicants must answer a questionnaire or interview in addition to submitting an application form.

1	Those raising children born between Apr. 1 st , 2022 ~ Jan. 31 st , 2023	Childbirth Subsidy 50,000 yen Child-rearing Subsidy 50,000 yen
2	Those expecting to give birth by Feb. 1 st , 2023 who have submitted a notification of pregnancy between Apr. 1 st , 2022 ~ Jan. 31 st , 2023	Childbirth Subsidy 50,000 yen
3	Pregnant people who have submitted a notification of pregnancy after Feb. 1st, 2023	Childbirth Subsidy ••• 50,000 yen
4	People raising children born since Feb. 1 st , 2023	Child-rearing Subsidy ••• 50,000 yen

- ※1 The Childbirth Subsidy is available per pregnancy, while the Child-rearing Allowance is available for each child for payments of 50,000 yen each.
- ♦ How to Apply ••• Application forms will be sent out to those who qualify under categories ① or ②. Please fill them out as instructed and submit them to the Childcare Support Division.

For those who qualify under ③ or ④, application forms will be issued after submitting your notification of pregnancy or after your interview during the household check-up visit.
