No charge for vaccines!

Regarding the COVID-19 Vaccination July 14 ~ present

 \sim [2023 Spring Vaccinations] end in August \sim

The 2023 Spring Vaccinations (commenced on May 8) targeting people 65 years and over, those 5-64 years old who have a high risk of becoming seriously ill and medical workers, will end at the end of August. If you wish to be vaccinated and fit the eligible criteria, please make an appointment, and receive your vaccine by the end of August.

\sim Vaccination against the Omicron Strain in Children Ages 5 to 11 \sim

The Omicron strain-specific vaccine for children can be administered to children aged 5 to 11 who have finished the first (1st and 2nd) or third dose of the conventional strain vaccine and come under any of the following categories. Please schedule a vaccination appointment online or by calling the phone center.

\sim Initial vaccination for individuals 6 months and over \sim

We will continue to administer the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine to those who have not received it and who have reached the age of six months (1st and 2nd doses for people aged five and over, and 1 to 3 doses for infants aged six months to four years).

\sim [2023 Autumn Vaccinations] are scheduled to start in September \sim

The vaccine targeting the currently prevalent strain, Omicron strain XBB.1, is scheduled to start in September. Vaccination tickets will be sent out sequentially from the end of August in order of (1) those who received the spring 2023 vaccination and (2) those who were not eligible for the spring 2023 vaccination. Vaccination tickets will not be sent to those who have an unused vaccination ticket, so please use the vaccination ticket you have. As the government has not announced the specific schedules of vaccination, details will be posted on the city website and announced in the next issue of "Public Relations Ichinoseki" once known.

Other Information

No more over-the-counter payments for high school student's medical expenses

From August 1 (Tuesday), medical subsidies will be in effect at medical institution counters across the prefecture for high school students (or individuals until the end of the fiscal year when they turn 18 years old). Medical expenses covered by medical insurance are subsidized. *Medical examinations, vaccinations, medicine container charges, room charges for hospitalization, etc., are not covered by the subsidies and must be paid.

\diamond How to receive the subsidy

(1)When visiting a medical institution in the prefecture

Show your 'recipient certificate' at the reception desk at medical institution

2 When visiting a medical institution outside of the prefecture

(or if you did not present your 'recipient certificate' in ①) Please pay upfront at the medical institution and bring the receipt to city hall to apply for benefits. The amount that was borne by you will be deposited into the designated bank account.

Eligibility Certificate for Ceiling-Amount Application GENDOGAKUTEKIYO NINTEISHO

If the medical expenses are high, please organize an "Eligibility Certificate for Ceiling-Amount Application" from your health insurance provider and present it at the medical institution reception desk. In some cases, such as when you do not show your certificate, you may need to return medical expenses that have already been subsidized.

Monetary support for raising children at home

♦ Those eligible

①Raising an eligible child without sending them to a childcare institution (daycare etc.)

- 2 Living with the child
- 3 Having an address in the city
- ④Not receiving public assistance

5 The applicant (and his/her spouse) are not receiving childcare leave benefits

6 Are not associated with organized crime, and do not engage in acts that violate public order/morals.

♦ Target children

- 1)Not enrolled in childcare institution
- ⁽²⁾They are the second or later sibling among siblings who have yet to complete high school
- ③Have an address in the city
- ④ Over 8 weeks of age, and under 3 years old

Amount of payment • 10,000yen a month per child

◇Payment Period

From the month following the month the target child in over 8 weeks old to the month the child turns 3 (or until the month before, if their birthday falls on the first). *Payment will begin the month following the month of application if the application is delayed
