No charge for vaccines!

Regarding the COVID-19 Vaccination

August 16 ~ present

~Vaccinations starting in Autumn 2023~

[Vaccinations starting in Spring 2023], from May 8 (Monday) to September 19 (Tuesday), is for people aged 65 and over and those with a high risk of severe illness, such as those with an underlying condition. Those who wish to be and are eligible for vaccination, should get vaccinated as soon as possible. From September 20 (Wednesday), the [Vaccinations starting in Autumn 2023] will commence. Vaccines that correspond to the Omicron strain XBB.1.5, which is the prevalent strain of the novel coronavirus, will be administered.

Primary series*: 1st and 2nd doses for those aged 5 and over, 1st~3rd doses for those aged 6 months to 4 years

- ◆Vaccination Interval: At least 3 months after the last vaccination
- ◆Vaccine being administered: Pfizer or Moderna monovalent vaccine against Omicron strain XBB.1.5
- ◆Number of vaccines: One dose per person from September 20 (Wednesday) to March 2024
- * Vaccines for those aged 6 months to 11 years old will start in October.
- ♦ Venue: 51 medical institutions across Ichinoseki *Ichinoseki General Gymnasium (U-Dome) is not a venue

◆Vaccination Ticket:

(1) Individuals without an unused vaccination ticket

(Example: People aged 65 or over who received vaccination after May 2023, people aged 5 to 64 who received Omicron strain vaccine, etc.)

- ∨ Vaccination tickets will be sent out from Sept. 1 to those who've had a vaccine by June
- Vaccination tickets will be sent out at the end of September to those who've had a vaccine in July.
- ▶ Vaccination tickets will be sent out at the end of October to those who've had a vaccine in August.
- 2 Individuals who have an unused vaccination ticket

List of venues

(Example: People aged 65 or over who have not been vaccinated since May 2023, people who have not been vaccinated against the Omicron strain, etc.)

- ▶ New vaccination tickets will not be sent out. You can receive vaccinations using your vaccination ticket.
- ③ Individuals who have moved from outside the city after a previous vaccination or who have lost their vaccination ticket
- ▶ Apply for issuance of vaccination ticket online or via the call center.

♦How to make a reservation:

Make a reservation online, via the call center or by directly contacting a medical institution

- ① Choose a vaccination site and make a reservation following the instructions specified by the medical institution.
- ② Pre-booking during regular visits

If you can confirm that you are eligible for vaccination before receiving your vaccination ticket, you can make an appointment in advance at your regular medical institution.

③ Omakase Reservation Postcard (for those over 18 years old)
Send back the postcard enclosed with the vaccination ticket to Ichinoseki City, and you'll be assigned a venue and date of vaccination.

♦Other:

- Those under the age of 15 must be accompanied by a guardian and have a guardian's consent (signature) on the screening form.
- People aged 16 and 17 do not require parental consent, however we advise that they are accompanied.
- Anyone who has contracted the novel coronavirus can still receive the vaccination, regardless of how long it has been since the infection, so long as their physical state has improved,


About the 42nd Ichinoseki International Half Marathon
