Regarding the COVID-19 Vaccination

September 14 ~ present

~Vaccines for 12 years of age and older~

Pfizer's Omicron strain XBB.1.5 have been available since Wednesday, September 20 for persons aged 12 years and older. Moderna's Omicron strain XBB.1.5 will begin on Monday, October 2.

The vaccination regime will downscale after January 2024, so those who wish to receive the vaccination should do so before December 2023.

~Vaccines for children 6 months to 11 years old~

Starting on Wednesday, October 4, vaccinations for Omicron strain XBB.1.5 for persons aged 6 months to 11 years will be conducted as follows. Those who wish to be vaccinated should make an appointment online or through the call center (0120-033-567).

- Subsidized Period: Oct. 1st (Sun)~Jan. 31st, 2024(Wed)

 - Please make a reservation in advance at a medical facility.
 - Vaccination tickets and pre-vaccination questionnaire are distributed by participating facilities.
 - Those wishing to get vaccinated at a non-participating facility should inquire at the numbers below.
- Note
- ① It is no longer necessary to wait before receiving the COVID-19 vaccine. Those who are worried about side effects, please speak with your doctor.
- ② Vaccines cannot be administered to those with a fever greater than 37.5° C or a serious illness.

③ In some cases, the doctor may decide to postpone vaccination. Please consult with your doctor on a day you're in good health to be vaccinated.

[Everyday Precautions are Important]

Vaccines are not guaranteed to completely prevent infection. Please be thorough with infection prevention measures such as mask-wearing, handwashing, and gargling.

Review the way you use your health provider

Many patients use emergency medical facilities (*) on holidays and at night, without seeing a doctor during weekdays or daytime hours. (* Prefectural hospitals and other hospitals that accept seriously ill patients requiring urgent hospitalization or surgery)

The congestion of emergency medical institutions on holidays and at night may cause delays in the treatment of severely ill patients.

~Requests when visiting medical institutions~

◆See your regular health provider (family physician) during office hours

A family physician is a medical institution that provides daily health management and initial treatment.

Family physician guidebook

♦If you have no choice but to see a doctor on holidays or at night, use the doctor on duty.

If you need to see a doctor on duty, please call the medical institution before you visit.

♦ Get health checks and take care of your health on a daily basis.
