Commencement of Facial recognition Individual Number Cards

The Facial Recognition Individual Number Card eliminates the need to set a PIN number and uses 'device-based facial recognition' or 'visual facial recognition' to reduce the burden on people who are concerned about setting and managing a PIN number.

- Available services
- Health insurance card (registration for use as a health insurance card is required)
- Identification documents containing face photo and personal information (name, date of birth, gender, address)
- Services that cannot be used
- Convenience store delivery of various certificates MyNaPortal Other online procedures
- * Both those who will receive an Individual Number Card in future and those who already have an Individual Card can apply.
