# Regarding the COVID-19 Vaccination

### ~Free COVID-19 vaccinations will end on March 31st~

If you have not received a novel corona vaccination after Wednesday, September 20, 2023 and wish to be vaccinated, please make an appointment as soon as possible.

If you do not have your vaccination ticket, please contact the call center.

\*Note: Sunday March 31st (the final day), medical institutions in Ichinoseki will be closed. [List of venues]

## ~Information on the novel coronavirus vaccination after April 1st (Monday)~ (As of Feb 15 to present)

Starting on Monday, April 1st, the novel coronavirus vaccination will be considered a "routine vaccination," similar to the influenza vaccine administered in autumn/winter for those 65 years of age and older, as well as certain

individuals in the 60-64 age bracket (\*). Ichinoseki City plans to subsidize a portion of the vaccine cost for those 65 years of age and older who qualify for the "routine vaccination".

Regardless of age or season, others can get vaccinated at their own expense.

(\*) Individuals between the ages of 60 and 64 who suffer from heart, kidney, or pulmonary conditions that significantly restrict their ability to go about their daily lives, as well as those who are unable to do daily tasks due to HIV-related immune system impairment.

- Post offices you can apply at: Ichinoseki, Ichinoseki Chuou-cho, Hanaizumi, Ohara, Surisawa, Okita, Senmaya, Konashi, Higashiyama, Murone, Usuginu, Fujisawa, Kinomi
- Other: Photographs will be taken at the post office.
  - \*Cards can be picked up at the main or branch office of the city hall in your area of residence.

#### ~Individual Number Card Application and Issuing Window Opens~

- \* Cards can only be received at the head office or branch office of your residential area.

## **Update your Individual Number Card upon change of address**

You must update your Individual Number card with the new address if your address changes.

Complete the procedure by following the instructions at the municipal office where you are moving to, along with filing a moving-in notification (also applies if you move within the city).

Use the PIN that you entered when you received your Individual Number Card to complete the process.

Please note that if any of the following apply, your Individual Number Card may become invalid and you may need to undergo reissuance procedures (for a fee).

- •When 14 days have passed since the day you moved in without submitting a notification of moving-in.
- •30 days have passed without the notification of moving-in being submitted from the scheduled move-out date reported in the notification of moving-out.
- •When 90 days have passed from the submission of the notification of moving-in without completing the procedures for the continued use of the Individual Number Card.
