Novel Coronavirus (for senior citizens)

Extending the period for subsidies for vaccinations

The subsidy period for COVID-19 vaccinations will be extended until Monday, March 31st. Those who wish to receive the vaccination should make an appointment early and get vaccinated.

| Eligible persons | Those with an address in Ichinoseki, ① Persons 65 years and older ② Persons aged 60-64 as of the date of vaccination whose immune function is equivalent to level 1 in the physical disability certificate for heart, kidney, respiratory system human immunodeficiency virus. |

| Grant amount | 11,800 yen per visit *Full subsidies for those living in households on public assistance. |
| What to bring | Individual Number card or health insurance card *Pre-examination and vaccination tickets will be distributed by the medical institution where the vaccination will be administered. |
| Vaccines administered | Vaccines available differ depending on the medical institution, so please inquire at the medical institution where you will receive the vaccination for details. |
| Vaccination Venue | Medical institutions in Ichinoseki City For more information, refer to the Ichinoseki City website or the October 2024 issue of I-style. Depending on the medical institution, vaccine administration may end early within this period. After February, vaccination costs will no longer be subsidized at out-of-town medical facilities. |

Information and a medical examination form will be sent to eligible applicants in April 2024.

Those who wish to receive the examination should make an appointment at a medical institution in Ichinoseki and receive the examination by the deadline.
